



PARISH COUNCIL VACANCY IN HOLYMOORSIDE

Following the recent resignation of a councillor one vacancy exists on the parish council and members are obliged to attempt to co-opt a member and are seeking expressions of interest from residents of Holymoorside ward.

For information, the full parish council is composed of ten members, seven representing Holymoorside Ward and three Walton ward. As the lowest tier of local government in England, parish councils are involved with, among other things, allotments, bus shelters, transport, crime prevention, education, highways, public buildings and village halls, recreation, seats and shelters, town and country planning, war memorials. The parish council also owns tennis courts and a bowling green.

If you are interested in being considered for co-option or feel you might be interested or require more information, please get in touch with me. All applicants will be asked to complete an application form, the decision for co-option will be decided on the information provided and should be submitted by the 9th June 2018. If you would like to meet the Chairman or any of the councillors, I am also able to arrange this. I am sure they will tell you that to represent people at council level is rewarding and worthwhile.
